Cytovia Therapeutics is a biotechnology company that aims to accelerate patient access to transformational immunotherapies, addressing several of the most challenging unmet medical needs in cancer. Cytovia focuses on Natural Killer (NK) cell biology and is leveraging multiple advanced patented technologies, including an induced pluripotent stem cell (iPSC) platform for CAR (Chimeric Antigen Receptors) NK cell therapy, next-generation precision gene-editing to enhance targeting of NK cells, and NK engager multi-functional antibodies. Our initial product portfolio focuses on both hematological malignancies such as multiple myeloma and solid tumors including hepatocellular carcinoma and glioblastoma. The company is establishing R&D and GMP manufacturing operations in the greater Boston area and partners with Cellectis, CytoImmune, the Hebrew University of Jerusalem, INSERM, the New York Stem Cell Foundation, STC Biologics, and the University of California San Francisco (UCSF).

### **Key Responsibilities:**

- Perform all Month End Close functions end to end supporting the Controller/Asst Controller including but not limited to; journal entries, account reconciliations, account variance analytics, bank reconciliations, oversight of all AP/AR transactions and ad hoc analyses.
- Capture and obtain as well as analyze large amounts of data from multiple sources to consolidate, develop into schedules, share with external vendors
- Lead efforts to automate various processes by developing a deep understanding of source data and end user needs by working with the team for implementation, design and oversight of the solutions
- Build and analyze complex management reports in a dashboard framework leveraging existing excel models as well as creating robust modeling including Vlookup's and pivot tables
- Assist in the Company's evaluation of technical accounting matters, including those related to complex transactions, emerging areas and adoption of new accounting standards
- Assist in the Company's SOX program including interfacing with internal and external auditors as well as business leaders
